1. Does AATSP-GA offer validation of participation for professional development purposes?

- Yes, every participant receives a personalized AATSP-GA **certificate for 5 hours of in-person professional learning**.

2. Does AATSP-GA provide invoices, and can I pay for more than one attendee? How do these teachers register?

- Yes, AATSP-GA provides invoices. Please, email RosarioVickery@clayton.edu Conference Director, to request an invoice.
- Please, provide your name, who to invoice, email address to send invoice, and names of teacher(s) registrations paid from this invoice.
Example: Invoice for Sunny County Schools, 200 Sun Road, Canterbury, GA 30845.
Paying for registration of 4 teachers: Cristal Díaz, Joe Miranda, Juana Smith, Joy Sanchez. **Teachers will register themselves at the AATSP-GA website but not pay individually.**
- After receiving your invoice, pay invoice amount at the conference Pay Button online at the AATSP-GA website or let Dr. Thomas Cremer know that you wish to mail a check.

3. Where can attendees park?

- Fishburne Parking is the closest parking lot to the Michael C. Carlos Museum. It is covered parking. Parking is free on Saturdays and cars do not need a decal. Enter Emory University campus through the main entry to Emory University and follow signs to Fishburne parking lot. The Fishburne Parking Lot address is 1672 N. Decatur Road, but **the Visitor Access** is from Fishburne Lane, located off Dowman Drive.
- Accessible parking and paths are available.

4. Is lunch included in the conference fee and is there a vegan option?

- Yes, lunch is included with registration, and a vegan option will be available.
